

Qs Beach Bug



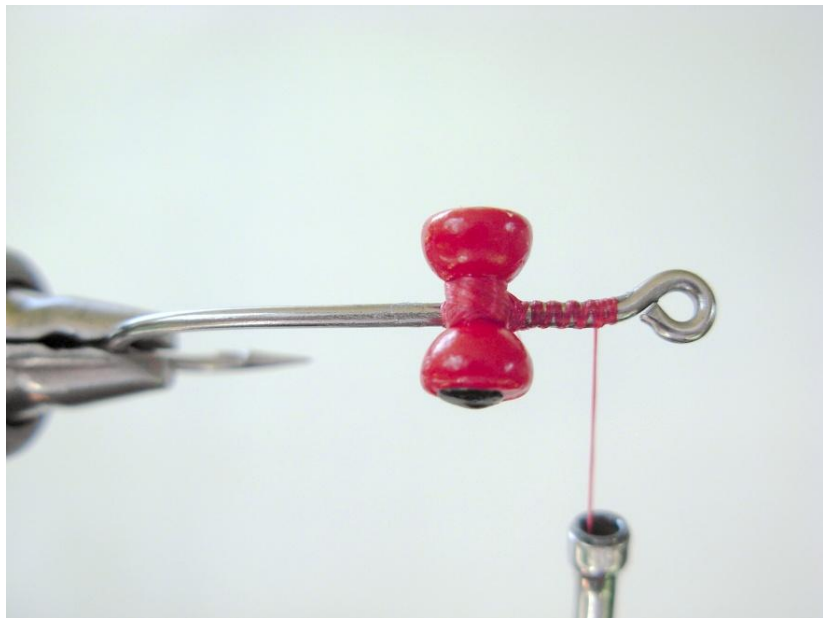
Here is a fly for fishing Pacific Halibut and any other species that will take it. Eric Rangel tie.

Hook: Saltwater #6 to #1/0
Thread: Red Nymo
Eyes: Medium pre-painted lead eyes
Underbody: Sparkle Emerger Yarn Burnt Orange
Tail: Grizzly hackle tips and Crazy Legs Orange-Orange-Black Flake tied in separately.
Body: Pearl Chenille medium Orange
Flash: Grizzly Krystal Flash Copper/Blue
Wing: Squirrel dyed Orange

Form a thread ball 1/3 of the hook shank from the eye.



Firmly attach the Dumbbell eyes on the top of the Hook. The eyes should not move!



Attach the Burnt Orange yarn at the hook eye, lay the yarn over the eyes and secure to the top of the hook shank.



Attach the hackle tips to the hook shank. One on each side, pointed down.



Attach the Crazy Legs to the hook shank, two on each side.



Attach the Chenille to the hook shank, wrap and secure the end on the underside of the hook.



Turn the hook over and secure the Krystal Flash. This is the orientation of the fly as it will be fished. The eyes are on the bottom of the fly.



Attach the Orange Squirrel tail by the butts to the area between the Hook eye and the dumbbell eyes.



This is the finished as it will be fished.
